

Operation Christmas Child – It is that time of year to pack a shoe box! It is simple, easy to do, and life changing, on both the sending and receiving ends. We will be accepting packed shoe boxes on Sunday, Nov. 12 and Nov. 19, after which they will be transported to the local receiving center. Using the "How to Pack a Shoebox Gift" envelopes in today's bulletin, follow the instructions on the tear-away form to shop for a boy or girl, age of your choice. Pack the shoebox. Complete the information requested on the envelope. Enclose a \$7 check per shoebox; this helps with shipping costs. Seal the envelope and place it in the wrapped shoebox. Wrap the lid separately so as not to seal the box shut. Tape the "boy" or "girl" label to the top of the box. Please put rubber bands around the box. Don't have an empty shoebox at home? You can buy that size plastic box with lid at Walmart, or any other discount store. These plastic boxes are put to multiple other uses long after the wrapping is gone.
