They are: Clean Water Projects/\$40 can provide drinking water for 3,000 people daily; Goats & Dairy/\$70 can buy a nanny goat who can produce a quart of milk a day; and Wool Bearing Animals/\$80 can provide a sheep, alpaca or llama to produce wool for clothing, and wool to be sold at market. To participate you can drop your cash or checks in the "barn bank" in the Upper Foyer, or put your money in one of two buckets any night at VBS. The adult VBS volunteer whose bucket has the most money by Thurs evening will get a . . . well, last year, they had to kiss a pig!!! This year, well, stay tuned
