From the Pastor's Study...

Easter came early this year on March 31st but that's not the end of the story but the beginning of a very hope filled April. The temperatures should be on the rise ... although we haven't had much evidence that warmer days are on the way. Let's please keep those who are living on the margins of society in our prayers this cold and rainy season.

Even though Easter has come and gone, there is a much larger narrative in our lives and the life of the church which we are called to pay special attention. That is evangelization. Our risen Savior calls us out of our comfort zones and into meaningful ministry and relationship beyond those we have in the present. I once heard someone put it this way ... think of all the friends you have yet to meet, now go out and find just one new friend today! Jesus calls us out of our easy chairs, our of our man caves, our beauty salons, our cubical at work, or just out of hiding behind the gas pump and offer up our time, talent, gracious words, and everything else you can think of – relating to the service and ministry of Jesus Christ.

All too often we have the image of ministry being the guy on Sunday in the robe at the pulpit. I think Martin Luther, the German monk who began the Protestant Movement, got it right when he offered up the notion of all the people in the church as the "priesthood of the believers". What Martin Luther stressed was the ability of the individual to pray directly to God instead of through a mediator such as the Virgin Mary or one of the Patron saints of the day. March Session Highlights

Providence Presbyterian Church conducted a stated session meeting on March 11, 2013 beginning at 7:00 p.m. at the church. Present were Moderator Reverend Jim Davis, and Elders Stephanie Bagley, Robert Joyner, John Kopanski, Wayne Lamm, Gary Phillips, Atlee Roberts, Kristy Stephenson, and Jeffrey Wood. Excused was Elder Nathan Dry. A quorum was declared and Rev. Davis opened the meeting with prayer. Gary Phillips presented the devotional titled "Much Troubles" taken from Joshua 1: 1-7.

There was no correspondence presented at this meeting. The minutes of the stated Session meeting conducted on January 14, 2013 were reviewed and approved.

Committee reports were made from eight of the standing committees of Session. No Personnel Committee report was presented. The Worship Committee reported the resignation of Wendy Stephenson as Children's Church Coordinator effective September 1, 2013. The following actions were approved by Session:

- The February 2013 treasurer's report (including capital campaign fund) was reviewed and approved.
- The Session agreed to review the church rolls at the April session meeting.
- A motion to accept the Dupree family as members was approved.
- The Session agreed individuals joining the church will be invited to meet with the session, either at a regular stated meeting or a meeting called for that purpose.

The Pastor submitted a report that detailed congregational concerns including the reception of four new members, Andy Dupree (transferring from St. Barnabas Presbyterian Church, Raleigh, NC), Sheila Dupree (transferring from Piney Grove Chapel Baptist Church, Angier, NC) and their sons, Matthew and Will, to be baptized and joining by profession of faith. Chellie Poston requests her membership to be transferred from Providence to Hephzibah Baptist Church. The Pastor reported on many of the upcoming events at Providence. Rev. Davis will attend the Sprunt Lectures in Richmond, VA scheduled for April 30 through May 3 as a continuing education opportunity. Also, the Pastor reported that the next two Presbytery meetings will be on July 23 at White Memorial in Raleigh and on October 26, 2013 at First Presbyterian in New Bern.

There was no old or new business presented at this meeting. The next stated session meeting is scheduled for Monday, April 8, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. at the church. Rev. Davis closed the meeting with prayer.
