While much of the world around us commercializes the coming of Jesus and many churches and religious services and programs do little more than stir up fleeting emotions that rarely result in life changing spiritual transformation, let me offer a thought or two which may impact our lives in 2013. These thoughts are inspired by Paul's compelling statement in Phil. 3:8, "I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord..." Please follow my trail through Scripture.

God the "IAM", revealed himself in the Old Testament,

- First to man in the garden with God's plan for an *intimate* relationship full of delight (Gen. 2:16-17)
- To Abraham "I AM your shield" (Gen. 15:1) and "I AM the Lord" (15:7) and "I AM God Almighty (17:1)
- To Moses God says "I AM who I AM" and tells Pharaoh "I AM has sent me to you" (Ex. 3:14), and "I the Lord your God am a jealous God" (20:5), "I AM compassionate" (22:27), "I AM holy" (Lev. 11:45), "I AM He, and there is no god beside Me" (Deut. 32:39)
- To Aaron: "I AM your portion and your inheritance" (Num. 18:20)
- To Joshua: "I AM the commander of the army of the Lord" (Joshua5:14)
- To Isaiah: "I, the Lord, the first, and with the last; I AM He" (Is. 41:4), "I AM He who blots out your transgressions for My own sake" (43:25), "I AM the first and I AM the last, besides me there is no god" (44:6)
- To Jeremiah: "I AM a God at hand, declares the Lord, and not a God far away" (Jer. 23:23)

... has now been revealed and spoken to us by His Son (Heb. 1:2),

- Who is the "I AM", the complete revelation of God, "for in Him all the fullness of God was **pleased** to dwell..." (Col. 1:19)
- Jesus said, "I AM the bread of life" (John 6:35)
- "I AM the light of the world" (John 8:12; 9:5)
- "...before Abraham was, I AM" (John 8:58)
- "I AM the door of the sheep" (John 10:7)
- "I AM the good shepherd" (John 10:14)
- "I AM the resurrection and the life (John 11:25)
- "I AM...your Lord and Teacher" (John 13:13-14)
- "I AM the way, and the truth, and the life" (John 14:6)
- "I AM the true vine" (John 15:1)
- "I AM a king" (John 18:37)

...and to complete the message of God's revealed Word, **"I AM the Alpha and the Omega" says the Lord God, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty"** (Revelation 1:8) May each moment of each day that is left to us be spent getting to know the **"I AM"** personally through His Spirit who dwells within us.
