May Session Highlights

Providence Presbyterian Church conducted a stated session meeting on May 13, 2013 beginning at 7:00 p.m. at the church. Present were Moderator Reverend Jim Davis, and Elders Stephanie Bagley, Nathan Dry, Robert Joyner, John Kopanski, Wayne Lamm, Gary Phillips, Atlee Roberts, Kristy Stephenson, and Jeffrey Wood. Excused were Elder Atlee Roberts. A quorum was declared and Rev. Davis opened the meeting with prayer. Stephanie Bagley presented the devotional titled "Patience is a Virtue, So Hurry Up and Read" taken from Hebrews 6:15.

Correspondence included three letters from the Board of Pensions, one in response to Providence's inquiry about their Relief of Conscience program , a second expressing gratitude for Providence's support of the Christmas Joy Offering, and a third in regards to proposed changes to its dues structure for the Medical Plan of the PCUSA.

Committee reports were made from eight of the standing committees of Session . No Property Committee report was presented. The Pastor's Report was also submitted. The following actions were approved by Session:

- The minutes of the stated Session meeting conducted on April 8, 2013 were reviewed and approved.
- The closing elder will collect and distribute the pew pad information after worship each Sunday.
- The Long-Range Planning committee is to develop a written policy for funerals and other events held at the church as a part of a wider effort to establish an operations manual for the church
- The April Treasurer's Report was reviewed and approved.
- A money market account will be opened at First Citizens Bank in order to earn interest on the money that has been received for the capital campaign, directing approximately 75% of the funds to that account. Session members signed a letter to the bank indicating that the accounting treasurers, Ann Benson, Wayne Lamm , and Kristy Stephenson should have access to the account.
- A job description was approved for the Personnel Committee.
- A Personnel Policy for the church will be completed by the Personnel Committee and submitted to the Session for approval.
- Job descriptions for paid employees will be updated and presented in a format consistent with PCUSA guidelines by the Personnel Committee and submitted to the Session for approval.
- The Personnel Committee will handle quarterly reviews with Rev. Davis going forward, with an annual review conducted jointly with the Session in August.
- The Personnel Committee will handle the annual review for director of music and custodian on or before August 31, 2013.
- The Session conducted its annual review of the church rolls of membership. The active membership now stands at 180 persons.

The next stated session meeting is scheduled for Monday, June 10, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. at the church. Rev. Davis closed the meeting with prayer.
