Providence Presbyterian Church conducted a stated session meeting on October 14, 2013 beginning at 7:00 p.m. at the church. Present were moderator Reverend Jim Davis, and elders Stephanie Bagley, Nathan Dry, Robert Joyner, John Kopanski, Wayne Lamm, Gary Phillips, Atlee Roberts, Kristy Stephenson and Jeffrey Wood. Excused was elder Robert Joyner. A quorum was declared and Rev. Davis opened the meeting with prayer. Correspondence included a note from Ted Churn, Executive Presbyter, New Hope Presbytery offering congratulations on the celebration of Providence's 86th Homecoming. A letter was received from Benson Grove Baptist Church soliciting support for a missionary team to the Philippines.

Reports were received from Christian Education, Congregational Care, Fellowship, Finance, Long-Range Planning, Mission and Outreach, Nominating, Personnel, Property and Worship Committees and from the pastor. The following actions were approved by session:

- The minutes of the stated session meeting conducted on September 9, 2013 were reviewed and approved.
- A donation will be sent to Benson Grove Church's toward the support of their mission team to the Philippines.
- The September Treasurer's Report was reviewed and approved.
- The 2014 budget was reviewed and approved. The budget will be presented to the congregation on Sunday, November 10, 2013.
- A letter to be mailed to all members concerning the church's annual stewardship campaign was approved.
- The church will enter into a cost plus contract with Dalton General Contractors, LLC for the construction project of a new fellowship hall and classroom addition.
- Upon approval from the congregation on Sunday, October 20, 2013, the church will proceed with a loan and will proceed with construction of phase 1 and phase 2 of the long-range plan with approval of the loan.
- Communications concerning the personnel concerns of any individual employed by the church are not to be communicated electronically and printed copies are to be restricted to those needed for permanent personnel files as well as additional copies for the work of the committee. Copies used by the committee are not to be destroyed after use.
- Mrs. Daphne Noles will be moved from the inactive roll of membership to the roll of active membership.
- An accompanist will be paid to play the piano for the Christmas cantata.
- \bullet John Kopanski will represent Providence as a commissioner at the October 26th meeting of New Hope Presbytery.
