Merry Christmas and Greetings in the name Jesus Christ!

The Advent Season is here and there are so many of our Lord's blessings to be thankful for. Our Gracious God gives humanity hope in the gift of the Christ child. God has blessed with the gift of having faith to see beyond ourselves and acknowledge God as the one true source of life and joy. We are so very blessed to be loved by our Lord God who sacrificed His only Son, Jesus, to proclaim a new covenant with humanity.

The virgin's name was Mary. 28 And he came to her and said, "Greetings, favored one! The Lord is with vou." <sup>29</sup> But she was much perplexed by his words and pondered what sort of greeting this might be. 30 The angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. 31 And now, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you will name him Jesus. 32 He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give to him the throne of his ancestor David. 33 He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end."
