Happy New Year!



The friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly at the bridegroom's voice. As well, Elders elect present at the meeting were: Beth Breeden, Margie Taylor, Pete Booth, David Nelms, and Steve Nordan. The meeting was moderated by Reverend Jim Davis. A quorum was declared and the Moderator Reverend Jim Davis opened the meeting with prayer.

- > The minutes from stated Session meetings for October and November 2013 were reviewed and approved by the Session.
