The season of Lent begins with Ash Wednesday occurs on Wednesday March 5th; Lent is the forty-day liturgical season of fasting and prayer before Easter. The forty days represent the time Jesus spent in the desert, where, according to the Bible, he endured temptation by Satan. The purpose of Lent is the preparation of the believer—through prayer, penitence, almsgiving and self-denial—for the annual commemoration of the Death and Resurrection of Jesus, as celebrated during Holy Week, which recalls the events linked to the Passion of Christ and culminates in Easter, the celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

In our time March means many things, it's a time to turn our clocks ahead, maybe a chance for a few snowflakes to fall, NCAA basketball March Madness, and ultimately the end of winter and the beginning of spring.
