February is upon us once again – BUT in a new way! While it is cold outside it is heating up on the inside of the walls of Providence Presbyterian Church. As we put on our coats and sweaters to face the cold weather outside, let us greet those whom God places in our lives with all the warmth and joy of knowing our LORD and Savior has done the greatest thing of all for each and every one of us.

February has always been a month of many opportunities – here we have the Presbyterian Women's Chicken and Pastry Dinner and Silent Auction, Souper Bowl, Valentine's Day, President's Day, Martin Luther King Day, and Ash Wednesday which heralds the coming of Easter.

Our scripture of the month is Psalm 119:10-18, which proclaims the Word of the Lord to be the central thing on which we are to hold fast to and the live out our lives centered upon it. There will be a short Congregational Meeting on Sunday, February 14, 2016 following worship service. The purpose of the meeting is to elect the board of directors for the church corporation.




### YOUTH SPOTLIGHT
