

## Highlights of Minutes from September 9, 2019 Stated Session Meeting

#### Correspondence

- Letter of resignation from Elder Cathy Simmons,
- Email from Elder Jonathan Kershaw announcing his resignation as Elder,
- Email from New Hope Presbytery with approval to move forward with interviews of two candidates for transitional pastor, and
- Email on August 30, 2016 from Bucky Hunsicker, Administrative Director the Presbytery of the Mid-Atlantic (PMA). He informed us Providence is currently a "Transitional" member and will become a full member upon examination and acceptance of our Elders in accordance with the EPC Book of Order.

#### **Open and Actionable Items**

**Finance** – The August 2019 financial report was reviewed. Giving continues to be weak. General Fund giving continues to track below expenses. Overall receipts currently are slightly ahead of expenses due to \$24,108.62 in gifts from the Presbyterian Women and Men's Fellowship received during the spring.

**Budget Meeting** – Session agreed to meet on Monday, September 16, 2019 to prepare a budget for 2020. **Homecoming Letter** – A draft of the Homecoming letter was reviewed. A few modifications were approved by common consent. The letter will be updated and mailed out the week of September 15th. **Motion to Receive Resignations** – A motion was approved to receive the resignations of Cathy Simmons (effective December 31, 2019) and Jonathan Kershaw (effective August 15, 2019).

**Session Vacancy** – The need for an elder to assume leadership of the Fellowship Committee was discussed. A motion was approved to allow Carolyn Johnson to assume the responsibility for both Fellowship and Congregational Care through December 31, 2019.

Officer Nominating Committee – The size of the Nominating Committee was discussed. Five members of the congregation have agreed to serve on the committee – 1 from each of the 5 adult Sunday School classes. Session agreed that a larger representation from the congregation than from the Session is desired. A motion was approved to include 2 Elders from the Session class of 2019 on the committee. One of the two elders will chair the committee. It was agreed to ask the congregation to recommend active members for consideration as nominees for vacancies on the Session. Mary Ann Booth and Donna Stolle will serve on the committee.

**Relay for Life Team** – A motion was approved for the formation of a church-sponsored **Relay for Life** team. Cathy Maddux would be the organizer and team captain.

**Invitation to Attend the EPC Presbytery of Mid-Atlantic Meeting** – Session is invited to attend as observers on Saturday, September 28, 2019. The meeting will be at Myrtle Grove EPC in Wilmington, NC. Several Elders expressed an interest in attending.

## **Committee Updates**

**Mission & Outreach** – Appropriate hurricane response was discussed. A motion was approved to place a flyer in the Sunday bulletin informing the congregation that donations were being accepted during September and forwarded to Samaritan's Purse for hurricane relief in the Bahamas.

**Personnel** – Committee members will be scheduling time to work on detailing the procedures of the Personnel Committee. Revisions to the Secretary's desk manual are being made to better organize and streamline instructions.

**Worship** – The church will hold Communion on Sunday, October 6, 2019.
