

Results of Congregational Vote on Dismissal from PCUSA

On January 7, Providence held a Congregational Meeting to vote on whether or not to seek dismissal from PCUSA. There were 157 members present (82% of active members). A total of 155 votes were cast in favor of dismissal. Two votes were opposed to dismissal. The percentage in favor of dismissal was 98.7%. Jeb Jeuter and Nancy Warren, the Presbytery Discernment Team representatives, confirmed the vote count. Mr. Jeuter spoke to the membership following the announcement of the vote and confirmed that the next step will be the negotiation of the terms for dismissal. The negotiating team for Providence will keep you informed of news once the negotiations begin.

INSTALLATION OF ELDERS

PRESENTATION

- Pastor: There are a variety of gifts, but it is the same Spirit who gives them.

Will you in your own life seek to follow the Lord Jesus Christ, love your neighbors, and work for the reconciliation of the world? I will.

Do you promise to further the peace, unity, and purity of the church? I do.

Will you seek to serve the people with energy, intelligence, imagination, and love? I will.

Will you be a faithful elder, watching over the people, providing for their worship, nurture, and service? Will you share in government and discipline, serving in governing bodies of the church, and in your ministry will you try to show the love and justice of Jesus Christ? I will.
