

ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Session of the church approved the following safety/security procedures to be implemented in order to provide a safer environment for Sunday School and Worship Service. These new procedures come after a recent meeting at the church with the Church Safety Team, Session and Johnston County Sheriff Deputies Crocker and Strickland.

- 1. No exterior doors will be propped open during Sunday School or Worship Service.
- 2. During Sunday School, only four doors will be unlocked, those being the portico (covered drive-thru) door, upper fellowship hall double doors, main sanctuary door and handicap ramp door next to sanctuary.
- 3. During worship at 11:05 am, the back usher will lock all doors except the main sanctuary door.
