

Mission & Outreach, Food Pantry Donation Response Extension - During the months of April and May, the Mission & Outreach Committee accepted food donations for the West Johnston High School ("WJHS") Food Pantry, which provides food assistance for the local population. The committee Thanks the congregation for their generous support of this mission response. Our church family, as part of a collaborative effort, has made a huge impact with assisting those in need. The WJHS pantry staff are very appreciative of your efforts. During these times, demand for food assistance remains high. Therefore, the M&O committee has extended the food donation response for the WJHS food pantry.

Thus, during the month of June, the committee will continue to accept food donations in the church parking lot at the cooking pavilion. Donations will be accepted from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm on the following Saturdays: June 6th, June 13th, June 20th, and June 27th.

Food items most needed are as follows:

- Canned fruits, vegetables, meats, and soups (pop-top lids a plus)
- Whole grain pasta, brown rice, dried beans, and cereal
- Fruit cups, juice boxes, granola bars, crackers, popcorn, and sugar-free puddings
- Peanut butter and other nut butters
- Hygiene items

In addition, the committee will be accepting Bibles and Christian based books during the month of June. They can be donated on the dates and times designated for the food drive. The donations will be used to assist prison ministries worldwide. God's Blessings to All
