**Mission & Outreach:** M&O committee would like to provide the following information regarding our food assistance ministries:

**Backpack Buddies:** The committee received information from our ministry partners at Lighthouse Baptist Church. They informed us that the backpack buddy ministry will be conducted during the 2020-2021 school year. Obviously, due to COVID-19, there will be modifications in operations; however, one thing remains constant, the ministry needs inventory. Therefore, the congregation is invited to resume their food donations for this ministry. As before, your food donations may be placed in the blue containers in the upper fellowship hall.

Local Food Pantry Outreach: This is to inform the congregation that the M&O committee has decided to designate the West Johnston High School ("WJHS") food pantry as our primary partner for local community food assistance. We began our relationship with WJHS pantry in May 2020 as a response to assist those in need due to circumstances related to COVID-19. The committee's observations have determined that the program is well organized and efficient in operations. This food assistance program is in operation year-round. Our ministry relationship with Friendly Chapel will continue; however, it will be modified whereby donations will be solicited on a limited basis (e.g. mission project for VBS and other designated times). The rationale for this ministry revision is based solely on the number of clients that WJHS pantry serves which can range between 40 and 60 recipients each week; thus, their inventory needs to be replenished with greater frequency. You may place your donations in the blue containers in the upper fellowship hall. The congregation is encouraged to visit their Facebook page just search West Johnston High School Food Pantry.
