

The Worship Committee feels that we should take a tiered approach to returning to normal, and the Session approved the following process. We will implement this process starting on Sunday April 25th.

Step One: maintain social distancing and only require masks while singing. This will start on April 25th and go through May 30th. We will assess then to see if we are ready to start Step Two. **IF** the congregation feels comfortable, Step Two would be implemented starting the first Sunday in June, (June 7th).

Step Two: decrease social distancing to 3 ft between grouped chairs (the 3ft measurement is the new social distance requirement for middle/high school) and masks be worn during singing. This would be implemented starting on June 7th and would be assessed after the June 28th service. If all is going well, we would move to Step Three.

Step Three: maintain 3 ft. social distancing and masks be worn at the individual's discretion.

Step Four: eliminate social distancing upon national vaccination rate of 70-80%
