

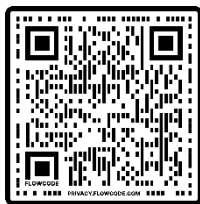

Operation Christmas Child (“OCC”)

Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes will be available to the congregation beginning Sunday, August 21st. The shoeboxes will be located in the upper fellowship hall foyer.

Last year, the congregation's support of this ministry provided seventy-four (74) children around the world with Good News and Great Joy. The ministry goal this year is to adopt one hundred (100) children. Each shoebox contains a brochure with packing instructions, gift suggestions, and a peel and stick label indicating boy or girl. Please enclose a donation of \$10 per shoebox. The \$10 is a critical element of this ministry to cover shipping and other project costs. The donation can be made by writing a check made out to Samaritan's Purse. In the memo line, write OCC and the number of shoeboxes the amount represents. Collection of the shoeboxes will begin on Sunday, November 6th (**requesting that shoeboxes not be brought to church prior to that date**). As well, our Dolls on Mission ministry is contributing Gospel dolls that you can incorporate with your shoebox ministry preparation.
