From the Pastor's Study...

Autumn has come and leaves are beginning to turn. October is a month we all look forward to for it is a time in which we reconnect with our extended church family! This year is our 89th Anniversary of being the body of Christ in the McGee's community. It is with great thanksgiving that the Spirit continues to move us forward in our mission and ministry beginning yet another new chapter in our history of being Christ's church. This month begins with World Communion Sunday on October 2nd – a celebration of the unity and mission of Christ's Church! October's scripture passage comes from the Gospel of Matthew, where Jesus speaks to only those who are burdened ... 


FELLOWSHIP HALL POLICY

SENIOR CITIZEN LUNCHEON


There will not be a Senior Citizen Luncheon in October due to church Homecomings.
