

## Highlights from Minutes of Stated Session Meeting July 10, 2017

## Action Items

- <u>Motion from Youth Christian Education</u> Session approved a motion to permit a fundraiser for the Youth Ministry. The proceeds will be used to fund youth missions, retreats, and activities.
- <u>Motion from Mission & Outreach</u> A motion was approved to add two new procedures related to the Food Pantry to the church policy manual.
- <u>Gracious Dismissal Plans for Congregational Vote on New Denomination</u> The Session agreed to move forward with plans to hold a congregational vote to determine the denomination we will transfer to after dismissal from PCUSA. A subcommittee was formed to develop information and a communications plan. As part of the communications, the Session will present its recommendation. The Session set a goal of holding the congregational vote in August.

## **Committee Updates**

<u>Adult Christian Education</u> - Session was informed of the plans by the Presbyterian Women to sponsor a Women's Event at the church on a yet to be determined Saturday in January or February of 2018. Additional details will be shared as available.

<u>Finance</u> - Sam Stephenson presented a detailed financial report updated through June, 2017. The church continues to experience a short-fall in general fund giving versus expenses. June and year-to-date figures:

<u>Mission & Outreach</u> – The committee will continue its monthly meeting with residents of Stage Coach Manor. They will meet with residents at the two locations where they are now residing. <u>Property</u> – It was reported that the two doors that flank the double doors providing entry to the foyer outside the new fellowship hall were found unlocked. These doors should never be unlocked.

<u>Worship</u> – A meeting is planned with the ushers to provide additional training. The Committee seeks recommendations for a solution to an issue with the floral arrangement. The arrangement is blocking visibility for people seated on the left side of the pulpit.

<u>Long Range Planning</u> – The committee will work with the Worship committee to create an implementation plan in anticipation of a need for two worship services to accommodate more people.

Pastor's Report – Highlights from the report:

- Rev. Davis continues to meet with visitors who are interested in our church
- The Blood Drive held on June 16, 2017 was a success
- Personal Leave Rev. Davis provided this schedule for dates during 2017:
  - $_{\circ}$  September 27-28 vacation
  - $_{\circ}$  October 22-24 vacation
  - $_{\circ}$  December 26-28 vacation

<u>Gracious Dismissal Update from the SCC</u> - The Special Committee of the Congregation (SCC) received word on Friday, July 28, 2017 that the Presbytery of New Hope has appointed a Presbytery Engagement Team (PET). The PET will negotiate with your SCC the terms of our dismissal from PCUSA. The PET, we are told, will be the same individuals who served on the Presbytery Discernment Team that met with the congregation earlier this year. Members of the Providence SCC are Kristy Stephenson, Jeff Wood, Steve Nordan, and Mary Ann Booth.

Steps Completed:

- 1. In early June, the SCC mailed our response to the Presbytery's Request for Information to Ed McLeod, the chair of the Presbytery Discernment Team.
- 2. The SCC met with members of the congregation and Session during June to review church history with special attention to the acquisition of land.

Next Steps in the Process:

- 1. Negotiation of the terms of dismissal The July 28 communication indicated that one member of the PET is unavailable until sometime in early August. Once all members are available, the PET will meet to review our response to the Request for Information and schedule a date to meet with the SCC.
- 2. Once there is agreement between the PET and SCC on the terms of dismissal, the congregation of Providence will be called together to vote of the terms. Upon approval by the congregation, the Presbytery will vote on the terms of dismissal. Dismissal terms include such items as:
  - a. The name by which our congregation will be known following dismissal
  - b. Any donation agreed to by Providence to charitable organizations or the Presbytery
  - c. Retention by Providence of historical artifacts and documents
  - d. The Presbyterian denomination to which Providence will transfer following dismissal.

Timeline for Dismissal:

- The earliest possible date on which the Presbytery could vote to dismiss Providence to a new denomination is October 28, 2017, just three months after the commissioning of the PET by the Presbytery.
- The next date on which Providence could be dismissed is in February of 2018.

Action Required by Providence Congregation – The congregation must hold a vote to determine the denomination it will transfer to upon dismissal from PCUSA. The Session set a goal at its July Stated meeting to hold a congregational vote in August. A subcommittee of the Session is working to prepare information and communications for the congregation in advance of a vote. Please be alert to information about the selection of a denomination that you will receive by various means in the coming weeks.
