# From the Pastor's Study...

For those of us who are ACC basketball fans -March is known as March Madness, where the ACC Basketball Tournament erupts and we get a preview of the NCAA tournament to come. For the Christian church the month of March means an extraordinary time of year. For many Christians the season of Lent is apex of the church calendar. Lent is meant to be a time for reflection and meditation on our devotion to God who is devoted in care and redemption of our souls. It is a time of preparation to celebrate God's marvelous redemption at Easter, and the resurrected life that we live, and hope for, as Christians. God gave up much and allowed His only Son our Lord to die on the cross at Calvary in payment for our sins. And so it is fitting that we to give up something in recognition of God's great gift of the messiah to us sinners. Let us all celebrate the Lent season in meditation, prayer, and reflection on what our lives would be like had God chosen not to invest anymore in humanity.

This month's scripture passage comes from the Gospel according to Luke and the new beginning of seeing and hearing of the God of Abraham through the words of Jesus the Christ. Jesus charges his disciples with a full development of the higher law of love. Such teaching found in the New Testament marks a new understanding of God as much more than revealed in the Law of Moses. Jesus redefined what a relationship with God is to be for the Jews and the Gentiles. Belief or faith in our God of unimaginable love, grace and power is the message Jesus proclaims.

God's higher law of love is described by Jesus to include, but not limited to, what Luke chronicles in Chapter 6 as: "love your enemies ... do good ... expecting nothing in return" because even God "... is kind to the ungrateful and the wicked" and so Jesus points to what is often humanity's greatest challenge – "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful. Do not judge, and you will not be judged; do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven; give, and it will be given to you."

## March Scripture Passage

<sup>35</sup> But love your enemies, do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return.<sup>1</sup> Your reward will be great, and you will be children of the Most High; for he is kind to the ungrateful and the wicked. <sup>36</sup> Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful. <sup>37</sup> "Do not judge, and you will not be judged; do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven; <sup>38</sup> give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap; for the measure you give will be the measure you get back." **Luke 6:35-38**

## Highlights from Minutes of Stated Session Meeting, February 13, 2017

Church members Israel Morrow and Steve Wolak brought suggestions for improving church security. Israel offered to gather and provide to the Session information about security ministries at other churches. He expressed his willingness to provide training.

## Separation from PCUSA

The clerk informed the Session that members Jeff Wood, Kristy Stephenson, and Steve Nordan have agreed to serve on the Special Committee of the Congregation (SCC). Elder Mary Ann Booth will lead the SCC negotiating team when discussion begins with New Hope Presbytery on terms of dismissal from PCUSA.

## **Action Items**

- 1. <u>Personnel Committee</u> Two motions were presented to modify the Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual. Both motions set dates by which pastor reports must be submitted. Reports include the Mileage and Expense Reimbursement and the Monthly Pastoral report.
- 2. <u>Children's Christian Education</u> Session approved "Maker Fun Factory" as the 2017 VBS theme.
- 3. <u>Mission and Outreach</u> Storage space was approved for donations to food ministries in cages in the new fellowship hall closet.
- 4. <u>Property</u> The existing 100 watt light in the upper parking lot will be replaced with a 350 watt light. Johnny Wood will try to have new entrance markers in place by next Session meeting.
- 5. <u>Youth Christian Education</u> Youth Worship on Sunday, April 30, 2017.
- 6. <u>New Comer's Class</u> Rev. Davis will conduct a class for new comers on four Sundays beginning March 5, 2017 during the Sunday School hour.
- 7. <u>Pastor's 2017 Objectives</u> Revisions to Rev. Davis' objectives were reviewed and approved.
- 8. <u>Long Range Planning</u> A sub-committee will begin developing plans for a campaign no sooner than 2018 to pay down the principle on the building loan.

## **Committee Reports**

<u>Youth Christian Education</u> – The Session declined to approve sponsorship of church youth attendance at Montreat this summer.

<u>Congregational Care</u> – Rev. Davis reports that our sound system appears not to be working and offered to review the equipment needs and price a solution.

<u>Finance</u> – Sam Stephenson presented a 2016 year-end detailed financial report. A report of January's receipts and expenses was presented. The Session approved a payment of \$10,000 against the building loan principle.

<u>Property</u> – Kent Walton expressed appreciation for the repairs made to the handicap ramp by Ronnie Creech and Jimmy Stuart.

## **New Business**

<u>Missions and Outreach</u> is evaluating participation in the NDCOT adopt-a-highway program. <u>Easter Crosses</u> – The Session asked Johnny Wood to see to the erection of the crosses this year.

<u>Compliance with Insurance</u> – Adequate coverage for children's classes was raised. Vickie Faircloth will check with insurance agent Kevin Creech regarding requirements.

Next stated session meeting will be held March 13, 2017 at 7pm.
