Highlights of Minutes of Stated Session Meeting October 8, 2018

Correspondence

A thank you note was received from Holden Swanson for the Bible given to him on Graduate Sunday. A thank you letter came from the principle of Swift Creek Middle School expressing thanks for the donated school supplies. Notification was sent to New Hope Presbytery informing them of the passing of Ruling Elder Laura McLamb.

Open and Actionable Items

Budget Review and Approval – Session approved the 2019 budget. A letter to the congregation announcing plans for Harvest Sunday was finalized. The letter will include a pledge card. Harvest Sunday will be celebrated with a lunch and review of the budget on November 4, 2018 following the worship service. Members of the congregation will be asked to bring side dishes and desserts. Copies of the 2019 budget and pledge cards will be placed in the foyer of the Sanctuary.

Property – The Session approved a motion to add handicap parking in the upper parking lot. The space nearest the office area will have lines and signage to define the spaces. Lines will be painted to designate no parking in front of the walkway in the middle of the landscaped island to stop people from blocking access to the walkway. Session was informed of ongoing problems with doors not locked and thermostats not reset following events at the church. The Fellowship committee will ensure that a coordinator is on hand for future events to ensure that the church is left in order. Issues with the coffee maker and the dishwasher were brought up. New instructions will be posted to help folks with proper usage.

Early Service Update – Plans have been finalized for February 2019 start. Communication plans to inform the congregation about specifics are moving forward.

Mother's Morning Out – Session received a report on similar programs at other churches and approved a request from the Children's Christian Education chair to continue exploring the possibility of having some version of a Mother's Morning Out program at Providence. At present we are not in a position financially to move forward.

Committee Updates

Worship – Session approved by consensus a plan to remove the PCUSA logo wherever it currently appears.

Youth Christian Education – The youth BBQ netted \$7,614. The chair of Youth Christian Education expressed appreciation for all the support the congregation gave to the event.

Long Range Planning – The Elder Nominating Committee has been formed. Members include Johnny Wood (chair), Kent Walton, Atlee Roberts, Eric Faircloth, Ann Benson, Donna Walker and Joan Stuart.

Finance – Session reviewed the September 2018 financial report. Giving to general funds was less than what was needed to meet expenses. Giving for the year is down 7.4% verses 2017.

Congregational Care – A report on members in long term care was received. Members of the committee continue to visit with them each month, taking copies of bulletins and CDs. The card ministry continues to be well attended.

Children's Christian Education – Twenty-nine (29) children attended the first LOGOS event. An issue regarding curriculum came up and was dealt with.

Clerk Report – An update of the list of active members was made and sent to Rev. Davis and the church secretary. Membership currently stands at 196.
