Since the summer of 2017 the Session has been considering the need, or not, to provide an early service at PPC; in addition to the 11:00 am service. The Long Range Planning Committee and the Worship Committee were tasked to come up with a proposed early service plan.

With an additional service, this is what Sunday morning would look like at PPC:

- 8:45am -- 9:30am, Early Worship
- 9:30am -- 9:45am, First Fellowship
- 9:45am -- 10:25am, Sunday School
- 10:25am -- 11:00am, Second Fellowship
- 11:00am -- Traditional Worship

Session has decided to implement an early service starting Sunday, February 3, 2019. A meeting is scheduled to take place on Sunday, January 20, 2019, directly after worship. At that time, we will share details of the plan and answer any questions you may have.

Highlights of Minutes of Stated Session Meeting December 17, 2018

Correspondence

Clerk of Session reported the receipt of the following letters from New Hope Presbytery:

- Forms from New Hope Presbytery for updating 2019 Elder contact information,
- Annual request from the Presbytery for report of changes to the Pastor's call and directions for submitting the 2018 Providence Statistical Report to the PCUSA General Assembly.
- The Clerk presented Johnny Wood with a certificate from New Hope Presbytery recognizing his 25 years of service as a Ruling Elder.

Open and Actionable Items

Children's Christian Education – A motion was approved for a fundraiser to help fund children's programs. Funds would be raised by selling high quality casual apparel and caps with the church name and/or logo.

Personnel – A motion passed to approve revisions to the pastor's 2019 evaluation form.

Clerk of Session – A motion was approved to replace the PC(USA) logo on baptism, membership, and confirmation certificates with a Celtic cross. A motion was approved to present revisions to the church bylaws to the congregation for vote at the next congregational meeting. The changes will replace references to PC(USA) and its book of order with references to the Evangelical Presbyterian Church and its book of order

Worship – An early worship service is scheduled to begin in February. Session approved an announcement for publication in the January newsletter and Sunday bulletins in January. Session will seek a volunteer to repaint the nativity scene prior to next Christmas.

Fellowship – Session approved a modification to the policy and procedure manual regarding the use and rental of the fellowship halls. A note was added to clarify that although no fee is required from members, a donation would be appreciated. Guidelines for Homecoming have been written. Session approved including the guidelines in the church policy and procedure manual.

Committee Updates

Worship – Mugs with the church logo will be offered for \$5 each for a limited time.

Youth Christian Education – It was reported that in addition to caroling recently, the youth shopped and spent \$1300 received as donations for the Angel tree on gifts for local families. An initial organizational meeting for the upcoming confirmation class was held. A meeting with parents and teachers will be held on January 6, 2019.

Financial – During November, giving to general funds was below what was needed to meet expenses. Giving for the year is down 7.19% versus the same period 2017. He reported that we are now using designated funds to cover expenses.

Children's Christian Education – A meeting will be held in February to discuss Vacation Bible School. Elders will be asked to participate in LOGOS in the upcoming months. Elders will be asked to speak to the LOGOS participants regarding such topics and liturgical colors, baptism, etc.

Pastor's Report – Rev. Davis provided a copy of his report. Highlights include:

- Visited our members in long term care
- Taught the Seekers class in November
- Participated in an organizational meeting with the Confirmation teachers and organizers
- Met with incoming elders for training
- Lunched with local pastors
- Attended the Seniors' luncheon in November
