From the Pastor's Study...

Where did January and February go? In many ways the beginning of 2019 has been a bit foggy for me. I want to thank everyone for your patience, prayers, cards, visits, and well wishes concerning my time away from the church convalescing from the surgery. I am joyful to be back in the swing of things and am doing my best to catch up at church and at home. Winter is coming to an end and both Spring and March Madness will begin on March 20th and don't forget to set your clocks forward. (*Spring forward – Fall backward*)

This year's Lenten season begins with Ash Wednesday on March 6th which concludes on Easter on April 21st this year. Traditionally, Lent is the forty-day time of fasting and prayer before Easter. The forty days represent the time Jesus spent in the desert, where, according to the Bible, he endured temptation by Satan prior to His crucifixion. The purpose of Lent is the preparation of the believer - through prayer, penitence, self-denial - for the almsgiving and commemoration of the Death and Resurrection of Jesus, as celebrated during Holy Week, which recalls the events linked to the Passion of Christ and culminates in Easter, the celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. In our busy lives we often forget that our God blesses us in a multitude of ways. When we experience joys or sorrows, elation or devastation, love or hate - God is beside us through it all. Jesus calls us to follow God's will for our lives throughout the good and the bad. The awesome hope found in the Easter message is that our fate is not fate at all but our lives are in God's hands and that our sins have been redeemed through the blood of Christ and nothing to do with our actions at all. In fact our only decision is to accept or reject God in our lives.

Our next get together will be Tuesday, 26 March 2019 at 10:00 am in the UFH.



Highlights of Minutes from February 11, 2019 Stated Session Meeting

Correspondence

Clerk of Session reported the receipt of several notes and letters of thanks to the Session and congregation.

Open and Actionable Items

Early Worship – Search for a pianist will resume with plan to initiate early worship in mid-March.

Logo for Fundraiser – Session agreed to the use of the logo that was used for VBS T-shirts last July for the apparel that will be sold to raise funds for children's ministries

Property – Session declined a request to use the church parking lot as a training site from an individual in the community who has an fitness training business. Concerns regarding liability and church insurance coverage were raised as well as rejection of previous requests from small business owners to use church property.

Copier Codes – Copier codes were distributed to each Session member. They each know the code that they and their committees are to use. Discussion was held regarding recent problems with the copier. Sam Stephenson will contact Office Values, the supplier, and discuss the possibility of getting a replacement.

Visitor Bag Insert – Session agreed to the use of a flier in visitor's bags with a list of the church Elders and their email addresses.

One Great Hour of Sharing – Session received a report that PCUSA is no longer providing "fish" boxes for children to use to collect donations. It was agreed that this is a giving tradition we want to continue. A search will be made for an alternative for the boxes.

Committee Updates

Children's Christian Education – The committee plans to meet in February to begin planning for VBS. Long term viability of LOGOS was raised as a concern.

Congregational Care – A renewed push to get pew pads circulated is needed. An invitation will be placed in church publications inviting members to let the Chair know how they want to be cared for.

Fellowship – The committee is getting under way. Rev. Davis suggested that Fellowship work with LRP on how the church can be more "visitor friendly." The visitor signs will be placed back on the ends of the third pews to remind members that these rows are for visitors

Financial – A motion was approved to have Wendy Stephenson take over responsibility as the church Accounting Treasurer. Her responsibility will be to write checks in payment for church expenses. Session received the January 2019 financial report. The principle balance on the mortgage has dropped below \$900,000. Giving to the general fund, while much improved from January of 2018, continues to lag expenses.

January 2019 General Fund Revenues General Fund Expenses \$20,130.52 \$25,866.72

Sam Stephenson stated that the church has not covered expenses since the beginning of the mortgage. The church needs to find a way to increase revenues.

Mission & Outreach – John Kopanski reported that lots of clothes have been donated for the residents at Universal Health Care.

Youth Christian Education – The "Souper Bowl" fundraiser was a terrific success and all who participated were thanked. More than \$1,500 was collected and nine of the church's youth participated. Plans are being made for both a Youth Mission trip and a Retreat this summer. A motion was approved to hold Confirmation Sunday on May 12.

Worship – Donna Stolle reported that a suggestion had been received that "thank you" notes be sent to anyone making a donation to the church in memory or in honor of someone. Sam Stephenson remarked that he believed that this was being done, but that he would follow up with Ann Benson, the Collections Treasurer.

New Business – Session discussed the need to announce every time communion is held that the bread used is gluten free.
