From the Pastor's Study...

Seems like the winds of March were in April this year! Never-the-less warmer and sunnier days are ahead of us and that means we look forward to: Mother's Day, Youth Sunday, Confirmation Sunday, Pentecost Sunday, Memorial Day, the annual Fish Fry, and our Logos Year End Celebration! This year's Easter celebration reminds us that our Lord God showers us with the rich blessings of the ministry of Jesus, family, church, love, scripture, Christian fellowship and our one true hope in this world ... saved by the blood of Jesus! Let us remember those who have given their lives so that we can live in a free country. We are called to study and grow into mature Christians and are commanded by God to share God's love with each other - let us make time to take time with those

In this month's scripture passage, John 20:18-23, we see our Christ Jesus encounter Mary Magdalene and the disciples. As so many times before, when God meets humanity, Jesus offers a familiar greeting in proclaiming "Peace be with you". Jesus then goes on to say "Receive the Holy Spirit" and bids them to forgive the sins of others. In this passage we also encounter Jesus as the recently risen Messiah heralds: Peace – the Holy Spirit – and forgiveness; these things are central to the Easter narrative and the nature in which our God seeks a relationship with each and every one of us.

May Scripture Passage

22 We know that the whole creation has been groaning in labor pains until now; 23 and not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the first fruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly while we wait for adoption, the redemption of our bodies. 24 For in hope we were saved. Now hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for what is seen? 25 But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience. 26 Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but that very Spirit intercedes with sighs too deep for words. 27 And God, who searches the heart, knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.



Highlights of the Minutes from the April 8, 2019 Stated Session Meeting

Welcome Center – Session approved in concept establishing a welcome center in the foyer of the Upper Fellowship Hall. Vickie Faircloth agreed to look for ideas for a desk. The need for a group of volunteer greets was discussed. It was agreed that going forward, the elder of the month will greet at the double doors near the upper fellowship hall.

Pianist for Early Service – A job description and terms of employment for the early service pianist position were reviewed and approved. Session agreed that the pianist would be paid once a month, after services are rendered.

Review of Membership Roll – The Clerk presented a list of individuals who are on the Inactive Roll. Some individuals have been in inactive status since 1994. With a few exceptions, the Session agreed by consensus to dismiss those on the list.

Committee Updates

Adult Christian Education – David Collier reported that he continues to work with members between the ages of 18 and 30 to develop a format for regular meetings on Wednesday nights.

Children's Christian Education – Vickie Faircloth reported that there will be an Easter Egg hunt at the church on April 20, 2019. The upcoming LOGOS end-of-year celebration will be opened to the entire congregation.

Fellowship – A motion was made and approved to designated areas of the church to be used by bridal parties while preparing for weddings. Brides and their attendants will use the Choir Rehearsal room. The Youth Center will be available for use by grooms and their attendants.

Financial – Copies of the March 2019 financial report and reviewed. Sam reported that the 2018 Homecoming collection was paid against the loan principal bringing the principal on the loan down to \$860,679.34.

Clerk Report – Mary Ann Booth presented Session with a report on the status of negotiations for release from New Hope Presbytery. Session received a list of the individuals who were moved to the Inactive Roll as a result of Session action during the March Stated Meeting.
