From the Pastor's Study...

Give Thanks with a Grateful Heart

This morning, I woke up ten minutes after my alarm went off, I spilt my coffee all over my desk, including on my tablet (nothing was permanently hurt), and a pulled ligament in my ankle decided to rear its ugly head in warning that I went too far by wearing high-heel shoes in worship the day before. Did I also mention it was Monday?

And in the midst of all this I hear a sinister voice say, "Somedays aren't worth it, are they?"

Trouble, like the poor, seems as if it will always be with us. Somedays it's personal, knocking at your front door, spilling down the front of your white shirt; other days it's at arms distance, rumors of war and natural disasters. It can seem as if we're never going to get a break and the hamster wheel is only going faster. Trouble makes it hard to raise holy hands up in thanksgiving.

But this is the season of Thanksgiving, right?

Despite the trouble in our lives, there is a sure, steady reason to give thanks always. Jesus told his disciples, "But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid." (John 14:26-27)

Providence Presbyterian Church conducted a Stated Session Meeting on October 12, 2020 at 7:00pm in the Choir Rehearsal Room. All seated Elders were present. Ruling Elder serving as Clerk, Mary Ann Booth and Moderator Rev. Nadia Stropich were present.

Omnibus Report

The Omnibus Report of committee minutes, communications, and reports from the Pastor and Clerk was reviewed. Session voted to approve a motion to accept the report.

Financial Report

Sam Stephenson reviewed the Financial Report for September 2020. Session approved a motion to accept the report. Monthly and annual expenses continue to outpace giving. Highlights of the report include:

Report on General Assembly Meeting

Session received a verbal report from David Collier on the 2-day online General Assembly meeting, held September 17th and 18th. David reported that the meeting was very relaxed. There was prayer between each item on the docket. There was open debate that was cordial, but a true debate. Question were accepted from anyone in attendance. Pastor Nadia remarked that this is how it always is and that we are very fortunate in our Presbytery (PMA).

Old Business

Personnel Committee motions to approve a revised job description for the Providence Administrative Assistant and work instructions for reserving use of the fellowship halls were considered. Copies were included in the Omnibus report. Both motions were approved.

New Business

Personnel

- David Collier presented the Committee's recommendation for the Pastor Compensation Package to be included in the Church Information Form (CIF). The total amount of the package is \$97,000.
- A Motion from Personnel was approved to give a one-time addition of 5 days to the Church Administrative Assistant an additional 5 days of vacation for 2021. The addition will correct for an error in a previous year.

Finance

Budget Review – Sam Stephenson presented the draft of the 2021 Budget. Several areas of potential savings were identified. The motion to accept the Budget of 2021 as presented was approved. November 15, 2020 (Harvest Sunday was approved for holding a Congregational Meeting to the review the budget. Stewardship Sunday will follow on November 22, 2020. A letter announcing Harvest Sunday and Stewardship Sunday was approved to be mailed to the congregation

Mission & Outreach

- A motion was approved to obtain a church credit card so that the pastor can help with rental and utilities assistance was approved. Funds would come from the pastor's discretionary fund.
- A motion was approved to allow M&O to solicit financial gifts from the congregation to support the missionary outreach ministry of Andrew and Norine Brunson.

Elder Nominations for Class of 2023

- Pastor Nadia reviewed the process with Session and referred Session to a letter and list of recommended readings that explain the spiritual nature of Elders. Scott Martin and Kevin Creech were approved by motion to serve as the two seated Elders on the committee. They will serve as co-chairs.
- Three "at-large" members of the congregation will be chosen from among recommendations provided by the members of the adult Sunday School classes. The Elder Nominating Committee will be in place by October 20th. The congregation will be encouraged to submit names of active members for consideration to the members of committee so that a slate can be presented to the congregation in advance of the vote.
