#### Highlight of Minutes of Stated Session Meeting December 14, 2020

Providence Presbyterian Church conducted a Stated Session Meeting on December 14, 2020 at 7:00pm in the Choir Rehearsal Room. All seated Elders were present. Ruling Elder and Clerk, Mary Ann Booth, and Moderator, Rev. Nadia Stropich were present. Nominees for the class of 2023 and to fill a one-year term in the class of 2021 were in attendance and given Voice for the meeting.

#### **Omnibus Report**

The Omnibus Report of committee minutes, communications, and reports from the Pastor and Clerk was reviewed. Session voted to approve a motion to accept the report.

#### **Old Business**

#### **Financial Report**

Sam Stephenson's report included reminders that 1) we are still paying the mortgage at the old rate and 2) the dismissal payment of \$12,000 is due to New Hope Presbytery before the end of the month. Sam explained that a donation of \$1,000 had been received that provided two options for the use of the funds. Session supported placing the funds in the Development fund for next year's dismissal payment to New Hope. It was noted that total expenses once again exceeded receipts in the month of November.

The committee **motion** to approve the November financial report was approved by all.

**Session approved a motion** to pay the annual \$12,000 dismissal amount to New Hope Presbytery by December 31, 2020

#### **Property**

- Motion to rekey the outer perimeter door estimated at \$850 was tabled until the January Stated Session meeting Steve Newnam says it will cost around \$850 to rekey each outside door. Motion tabled for more study.
- o Motion to install security cameras around perimeter of building was tabled until January for additional information.
- o **Motion was approved** to install a single light door with tempered glass and a digital key pad/keyed lock in the open doorway of the common area inside the Youth center.

#### **Church Information Form (CIF)**

- Session reviewed the responses to Part 5, Questions 1 and 2 of the CIF. The responses will be updated in the CIF.
- Next Steps A meeting of the current Session and the 2021 Session was set for 9 AM Saturday, January 9, 2021. Work to be done are finalizing the Vison and Mission statements and preparation of a strategic plan.

#### **New Business**

**Congregational Care – Session approved a Motion** to allow the Fellowship and Fitness walkers to resume walking inside the church.

#### **Examinations of Elders**

- Session heard the Statements of Faith of Ruling Elders (RE) Kristy Stephenson and Kent Walton. Kristy and Kent have been nominated as seated RE's in 2021. Kristy will become the chair for Christian Education and join the class of 2023. Kent will become the chair for Congregational Care and join the class of 2021, filling the 1-year term being vacated by Carolyn Johnson.
- John Pickens and John Mott shared their Statements of Faith with Session and were examined by Session. John Mott will serve as chair for Property; John Pickens will serve as chair for Personnel. Session agreed by consensus that they had successfully completed their examinations and were accepted as Ruling Elders in EPC. Both have been nominated for the for the Class of 2023.

#### **Slate of Officer Nominees**

Pastor Nadia turned the meeting over to Scott Martin and Kevin Creech to hear a report from the Nominating Committee. Session heard a **motion from committee to accept**John Mott, John Pickens, Kristy Stephenson, and Kent Walton as the official slate of Ruling Elder nominees. The motion was passed unanimously. A congregational vote will be held following Worship on Sunday, December 20, 2020 to vote on the slate of nominees. The Ordination/Installation Service will take place during the Worship service on either the first or second Sunday of January.
