Providence Presbyterian Church Minutes of Stated Session Meeting July 12, 2021

Providence Presbyterian Church conducted a Stated Session Meeting on July 12, 2021 at 7:00pm at the church. Elders present were: Vickie Faircloth, Kristy Stephenson, Donna Stolle, John Kopanski, Scott Martin, John Mott, John Pickens, Sam Stephenson, and Kent Walton. Also in attendance was David Collier, Chairperson of the Pastor Nominating Committee. Pastor Nadia Stropich served as moderator. Pastor Nadia declared that a quorum was present and opened the meeting with prayer. The devotional was presented by Kristy Stephenson.

Review of Minutes and Omnibus Committee Reports

The minutes of the June 14, 2021 Stated Session Meeting, the minutes of the June 21, 2021 Called Session Meeting and the omnibus committee reports were reviewed by the Session.

Committees that have not meet were: Christian Education, Congregational Care, Finance, Mission & Outreach, Personnel, Property, and Worship. John Kopanski made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 14, 2021 Stated Session meeting and the June 21, 2021 Called Session Meeting. The motion was seconded by John Mott. The Session voted and the motion was approved. John Mott made a motion to approve the July 12, 2021 Stated Session Meeting agenda and the omnibus committee reports. The motion was seconded by Scott Martin. The Session voted and the motion was approved.

Pastor Nominating Committee ("PNC")

Pastor Nominating Committee Chairperson, David Collier provided the Session with a status report on behalf of the PNC. David indicated the committee continues the process of evaluating pastoral candidates. However, he conveyed that they have identified a candidate that appears to be a good fit for Providence and the committee may be close to making a recommendation.

David will continue to keep the Session informed of the PNC's progress and report as developments dictate.

Financial Report

Sam Stephenson reviewed the June 2021 financial report and provided the following information:

- Mortgage balance is \$615,142.43. Money Market Savings balance is \$85,970.45/
- Checking Account balance is \$108,064.27.
- Designated Fund book balance is \$91,940.50
- General Fund book balance is \$7,646.16
- Homecoming designated fund balance is \$27,861.40

Sam reported that the Capital Campaign to match the donor donation of \$42,000.00 to pay-off the balance of the PCUSA dismissal fee has been achieved. In fact, the donations exceeded the

\$42,000.00 by an amount of \$6,057.00. As previously determined by the Session, the amount of \$6,057.00 will be applied to the principle of the mortgage. *The clerk, working with legal counsel, will finalize the closeout of the dismissal process with New Hope Presbytery. This includes: submitting final payment, executing the Quit Claim Deed, and recording the deed with the Johnston County Register of Deeds.

Summary of Expenses and Receipts

General Fund Receipts June 2021: \$17,809.45 General Fund Expenses June 2021: \$21,942.74

Year to Date General Fund Receipts: \$145,131.13 Expenses: \$143,984.42

Sam informed the Session that it is time to think about the church budget for 2022. Each Chairperson will need to evaluate their committee ministries and plan their budgets accordingly.

At the August 2021 Stated Session Meeting, a date in September will be determined to conduct a dedicated meeting to establish a church budget for the year 2020.

Sam made a motion to approve the financial report for June 2021. The Session voted and the motion was approved.

Old Business

Policy Book Review

Pastor Nadia conveyed that she had received committee updates (program overview) which may be applicable for the policy book. Updates were received from the following committees: Worship, Fellowship, Property, Congregational Care, and Mission & Outreach. Pastor Nadia suggested that committee ministry overviews could be included in the policy manual; however, detailed committee activity and process should be conveyed in committee manuals, not in the policy manual. Pastor Nadia indicated that she will get in contact with Rich Lambert to send her and the Session the latest version of the policy manual. She suggested that each Chairperson review their section and update accordingly. In addition, committee information on the church's website needs to be reviewed by the respective Chairpersons and provide updates to David Nelms. *Additional policy book scrutinization will resume at the next scheduled Stated Session Meeting.

New Business

Long Range Planning ("LRP") Committee Motions

Motion From LRP: Upon conclusion of the Session Class of 2021 term, LRP Committee will no longer be a standing committee of the Session. The Session voted and the motion was approved with eight (8) votes in favor of the motion and one (1) vote not in favor of the motion.

LRP Chairperson, Scott Martin conveyed that it was the consensus of the LRP committee that this motion be presented to the Session. The committee will remain a viable ministry of the church and intend to regularly convene quarterly. In addition, the committee would convene to

act on requests from the Session through facilitating, planning, and assisting with implementation of a proposed projects or ministry concepts.

Motion From LRP: Establish a Capital Campaign to pay off the existing church mortgage in five (5) years or less with implementation contingent upon paying the total debt associated with the PCUSA dismissal fee and the hiring of a called full-time pastor. The Session voted and the motion was approved.

Fellowship Committee

Motion: To approved the rental fees for the use of the Lower Fellowship Hall as depicted on the chart (by reference, the fee chart will be inclusive of these minutes) with the provision that rental use of the Upper Fellowship Hall will be suspended until further notice. The Session voted and the motion was approved.

Homecoming Letter

Fellowship Committee Chairperson, Donna Stolle reviewed a draft of the Homecoming letter. As well as serving as an invitation, the letter provides an overview of church life over the course of the last year. Donna asked if there were any revisions needed. In response, John Mott suggested that reference of the cornerstone on the church dated 1921 be included in letter; as it represents the Centennial of Providence Presbyterian Church. In addition, Kristy Stephenson suggested that the youth mission trip be included in the letter. Without objection, the suggested revisions will be implemented. Donna indicated that the Homecoming letter will be mailed out around the middle of September 2021.

Christian Education

Christian Education Chairperson, Kristy Stephenson introduced the following motion with regards to the youth mission trip to Pennsylvania: Permit the mission trip chaperones to use the church credit card for gas and to assist with any emergency situations. The Session voted and the motion was approved.

Point of Personal Privilege from the Moderator of Session

This was the last Session Meeting that Pastor Nadia Stropich will serve as our Session Moderator. Pastor Nadia presented the following business items:

- Working in conjunction with the Worship Committee, providing suggested resources and possibilities to secure pulpit supply until Providence has a called pastor.
- A Session Moderator has been scheduled for our Stated Session Meetings until we have a called pastor. Pastor Nadia conveyed that our Session Moderator will be Reverend Mike Weaver from Grove Presbyterian Church located in Dunn, NC.
- Pastor Nadia suggested that if there are folks on our care lists that do not have internet notify them by phone that her last Sunday with Providence will be July 18, 2021.

Pastor Nadia provided closing remarks about her tenure at Providence Presbyterian Church. She conveyed to the Session that our purpose can be found in Matthew 28:16-20.

Prior to closing the meeting, Vickie Faircloth, on behalf of the Session, presented Pastor Nadia with a gift of artwork (God's Fingerprint); followed by expressions of Gratitude for Pastor Nadia's Ministry at Providence Presbyterian Church.

Being no further business, Pastor Nadia closed the meeting with prayer.
